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### Your organisation

Describe the type of organisation and include a good description of your own areas of activity/fields (Visual arts, Performing arts, Interdisciplinary art, Music, Architecture, Library activities, Ethnic culture, Literature, Culture and art education, Museum and gallery activities).

Partners specifications we are looking for, bellow:

- 1. A dance art group where are young people aged 18 to 29. Style: Norwegian folklore ensemble, or modernized folklore.
- 2. A lecturer who would talk about cultural education. For example, a history of how it works in your country, what the benefits are, the adaptability, the demand, what the involvement of young people is, how we can learn from each other, and so on. Audience young people up to 29 years.
- 3. A theater director or actor (preferably contemporary art) who could organize several theater practices (practical activities) and to tell something inspiring about theater.
- 4. Youth representatives in the fields of culture and art. It could be a group (dances/songs / or other artistic performances).
- 5. A group, a collective or other organization that uses various technologies in their artistic activities, for example, a collective or performer complements their performance with visualizations on an LED screen or draws with some exclusive technology, also dances with illuminated costumes and so on.

#### Partner role:

What role do you foresee the partner as having in the project? What value do you feel the partner can contribute to the project?

We will invite partners to come to Lithuania (everything is paid for from the project budget). Partners will be able to get acquainted with Lithuanian culture and present their own. Will have the opportunity to start a long-term cooperation.
